

DESCRIPTIVE TRANSCRIPT FOR THAT'S NOT TEAM SPIRIT

EXT. OUTBACK FARM HOUSE - DAY

A Dingo stands near a small outback farm house with patched walls and a tin roof. A single chair on the porch looks out to a lone tree. The wording "The ACMA presents" appears on screen.

EXT. OUTBACK FOOTBALL FIELD - DAY

An empty Aussie Rules football field, with blank scoreboard and empty grand stands is shown. The wording "Be deadly online - That's not team spirit, screenplay by Danielle Maclean" is shown.

EXT. OUTBACK HIGHWAY - DAY

A commuter bus bearing a graphic of a roaring tiger with the words "East Side Tigers" belts down the dirt highway.

[HONK! HONK!]

INT. INSIDE BUS - DAY

Inside we find the East Side Tigers Football Team,

BUD:

Hey, look at this.

Bud, a red headed Aboriginal boy swipes through the images on his phone smiling to himself. He nudges his team mate Johnno, who looks at the image.

COACH:

Sit down, shut up and stay focused! Don't fool yourselves, boys. The Emu's are going to be hard to beat.

The coach shows the team a set play on a clipboard. The teammates sitting behind Bud are looking over his shoulder trying to get a look at the image.

EXT. FOOTBALL OVAL (ENTRANCE) - DAY

The bus pulls into the oval. The doors open with a hiss, and out step 'the heroes'. The players all have a similar bounce in their step, chests puffed out. An Elder gives them some last minute advice.

ELDER:

Come on, boys. Go in hard, head over the ball, and tackle, tackle, tackle!

JOHNNO:

Right oh Unc'! Hey, Sharlise...

Bud and Johnno stride past two pretty girls, Sharlise and Kellie. Sharlise calls out.

SHARLISE:

Hey, good luck, Cuz!

[CHEERING]

EXT. FOOTBALL OVAL - DAY

The siren sounds and both teams run onto the oval, a dog does its business on the field leaving a small deposit of dog poo.

CROWD MEMBER:

Look there!

[LAUGHING]

[CHEERING]

EXT. FOOTBALL OVAL (GAME MONTAGE) - DAY

Montage of the game. Wide shot of Tigers playing with Bud at the front - the girls cheer from the fence line. Bud goes for a catch and slides across the ground into the patch of dog poo. Sharlise gags. Sounds of sympathy from the crowd. He rips off his jersey and reveals his fitness. Whistles and cheers of approval from all the ladies in the crowd. The Tigers are way in front. Bud kicks a final goal. The final siren sounds to cheers of approval. We see the scoreboard. The Tigers have won.

EXT. FOOTBALL STANDS NEAR EXIT - DAY

The girls stand near the bus with the rest of the crowd waving the team off. As Bud walks past, Sharlise shyly congratulates him on a good game.

SHARLISE:

Bud! That was proper deadly!

BUD:

Thanks. Wanna give me your number?

SHARLISE:

Okay.

BUD:

Or better yet, I'll give you mine.

Bud brushes Sharlise's hand as he reaches for her phone and puts in his digits. He hands her phone back and boards the bus.

BUD:

Sharlise! Send me something real good so I'll remember who you are.

Sharlise smiles at him, gushing. The camera darts over to Kellie who looks suspicious at Bud's 'request'.

KELLIE:

You're not going to send that. Are ya?

SHARLISE:

Yeah... It's only for Bud.

Kellie rolls her eyes and groans.

INT. INSIDE BUS - DAY

The bus is now on the road heading home. Boys on the bus all with phones out, text messages coming in left and right. Puddy gets a text and opens it. Johnno who is sitting behind him looks over his shoulder as it opens. It's a sexy photo of Sharlise, topless. Johnno reaches trying to snatch the phone but Puddy is too quick.

JOHNNO:

Oi! That's my cousin, you dog.

PUDDY:

Oh sorry, bros. Ricky sent it to me.

Johnno turns to Ricky, who is in the seat next to him.

JOHNNO:

Rick, you sending photos of my little cousin to everyone?

RICKY:

Hey, don't blame me. Talk to the dog poo dude over there.

Johnno looks into the seat behind waving his fist at Bud who looks up.

JOHNNO:

Well?

BUD:

Settle down, bro. All the girls on your phone are someone else's cousins or sister.

We see all the footy players on their phones busily deleting the image of Sharlise.

JOHNNO:

DELETE it NOW!

Johnno squarely grabs both collars of Buds' jersey

BUD:

Don't go getting all gangster on me.

THE DUST RISING INSIDE THE BUS AS THE FIGHT HEATS UP.

COACH:

Hey! What's going on?

[YELLING]

Johnno tries to grab Bud's phone off but it flies out the bus window in the struggle. We see the phone bounce along the ground. The screen smashes and plastic pieces breaking off until it settles to the side of the dirt road.

BUD:
